HOT TOPIC - New Renewal Letters - IREC has revised its license renewal notices. The new notices do not include a renewal form - they are simply reminder letters giving you important information about your continuing education.

Thank you for renewing your license online!

Please do not mail your renewal letter back to us. We cannot accept that letter to renew your license. If you send it to us with a check, we must return it to you. We don't want you to have a late renewal, so don't wait till the last minute, and thanks again for using our online services!

Did you know? An active real estate license requires E&O insurance. No E&O insurance equals a civil penalty fine. Remember to check the status of your E&O insurance before you change companies to make sure you will have coverage in place at the new office.
