Have you changed your home address or phone number? You **must** update your personal information with the Commission within **10 days** of the change. Change your contact information by logging in to the IREC online services. Its quick and easy!

If you take 2 *different* Core classes in a renewal period, one will count for your Core requirement and the other will count as an elective course! The Commission encourages you to take the Core course every year to stay up to date with changes in the law and issues affecting your real estate license and practice.

Agency Disclosure (Blue) Brochure There are no changes planned to the blue brochure this year. Please continue to use the brochure effective July 2009 as the most current version.

Changing Companies? Be sure to check whether your E&O insurance transfers to your new office before you move. You must maintain E&O insurance at all times while actively licensed.
