### E-Newsletter – Special Bulletin 6/4/10

We have learned there presently exists some confusion about whether a 15-hour course entitled “Personal Best”, offered by Charlie Nicks of Northwest Partners Marketing Group, is certified for real estate CE credit. It has been offered a couple of times, primarily in the eastern part of the state.

The answer is: “no CE credit is available” at this time. The course has not been certified by IREC, nor is it being offered through a certified provider. Therefore, IREC may not award CE credit for it pursuant to Idaho Code 54-2036.

We understand a few folks who submitted the course on a request for credit form initially were

told they would get the credit. However, we have since notified the affected licensees of the error, and their education records have been corrected. Therefore, to repeat, no Idaho real estate licensees have received or will receive CE credit for the course unless and until the course becomes certified and is offered through an IREC-certified course provider.

Should the course become certified, it will be assigned a course approval number and will show up as a certified course on our public education search at [www.irec.idaho.gov](http://www.irec.idaho.gov).
