Remember... to update your contact information through the IREC online services. The license law requires that you provide any changes in personal contact information or a name change to the Commission within 10 business days. This includes making sure we have a valid phone number on file.

E&O Insurance Renewal Time! The Commission's group E&O insurance policy with Rice Insurance Services is coming up for renewal on or before **September 30, 2012 at 11:59:59 p.m. MDT.**

Expiration of the E&O policy, even for a few hours, will result in imposition of a civil penalty fine. No exceptions!!

The premium for this year's policy is \$208 and will include the property management endorsement for all who purchase the Rice E&O insurance. This means no separate property management endorsement is necessary if purchasing E&O insurance through Rice.

Renewal packages were mailed to licensees at their brokerage address in early August. However, it is the licensee's responsibility to renew E&O insurance on time, even if he/she doesn't receive the notice in the mail. Renewals can be completed online at www.risceo.com (a \$5 convenience fee will be added to online payments made through the Rice website).

DID YOU KNOW?

The Real Estate Commission does not require licensees to take an ethics course. Rather, a quadrennial ethics course is a requirement for membership in the REALTOR® association. Some ethics courses do count for CE elective credit to renew a real estate license, however. Check the list of certified courses on the Commission public database search to see if the ethics course you want to take is certified for CE credit. You can also look up your own education record by logging in to the online services.
