

Timeshare Resale Info

If you are a timeshare owner or know someone who is, be aware of fraudulent or questionable resale activity which has been reported in some jurisdictions. The companies either offer to "buy" timeshares from the owners (with the owner paying the company to "buy" the property), or they offer to market the timeshares for resale for an up-front fee. There have been many ads on TV and radio, and even direct solicitation to timeshare owners by mail, e-mail and phone. As a reminder, an Idaho real estate license is required to broker timeshare properties located in Idaho.
