Timeshare Resales:

The Idaho Real Estate Commission (IREC) has received a few calls about the resale of timeshares.

Selling property for someone else, and charging a fee for the service, requires an Idaho real estate license. Sending mass email, regular mail, or calling Idaho citizens to solicit their sale or purchase of a timeshare is an act of procuring which requires a real estate license.

It is the location of the owner, and/or the location of the property, that determines jurisdiction. The location of the reseller is not relevant. IREC has no jurisdiction over transactions without some tie to Idaho, such as if an Idaho citizen seeks out a reseller to sell a timeshare property located outside Idaho.
